

Chamber Music Program Summer Day Camp



♪ What will the participants learn at the camp?

Practice teamwork in making music; know healthy use of body in music making, attend master classes; receive coaching from **music teachers and professional musicians**; and gain skills in self-guided musical learning; prepare music for performance.

♪ Will each participant have their own individual part?

Yes. Each group will have 3-6 players and each player will have their own individual part.

♪ What types of music will be played at the Chamber Music Day Camp?

If you choose **classical**, the music you play can be from Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Contemporary eras including music from Latin American composers like Piazzolla, Villa-Lobos, or music from Asian composers. If you choose **jazz**, you will be grouped in small jazz combos and play music from different jazz composers.

♪ What is the schedule of the Chamber Music Day Camp? Where will it be?

The Day Camp will be **2:30pm to 5:30pm** at the **LCHS campus** every day from **Monday, June 21 to Friday, June 25, 2010**. On the last day of camp, all students will perform in the chamber music concert.

♪ What is the cost to attend the camp?

\$180.00 per participant. Discounts are available. Please see registration form for details.

♪ Who can attend the Chamber Music Day Camp?

Students entering **6th grade and up** (no upper limits) in fall 2010 who play strings, woodwinds, brass, piano, guitar, percussion, or multi-cultural instruments.

♪ Do participants need to be enrolled in LCUSD schools?

No. All are welcome.

♪ Can siblings and family members be in the same group?

Yes, if you choose to do so. It will be great for your family to continue making chamber music after the camp!

♪ What do I have to do if I want to play with my friends?

You can attend the camp as a 'pre-formed' group, or specify your wish on the registration form. Players in the same ensemble group need to have similar performing skills.

♪ Do participants need to have an audition?

Only students who are not in the LCHS Instrumental Music Program will need an audition or recommendation from the private music teacher. This will help us determine what group is best for you.

♪ What is my next step to attend the Chamber Music Summer Day Camp?
