MAR 14, 2018: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT Depart from the USA for your custom 8-day performance tour of Ireland!

MAR 15, 2018: DUBLIN Welcome to Ireland! Arrive in Dublin and meet your Tour Manager. Begin your adventure right away by taking a guided city sightseeing tour of Ireland's capital city! Finally, enjoy a visit of St. Patrick's Cathedral before checking in to the Maldron Newlands Cross hotel. At 7pm, have dinner together at the hotel and settle in for a good night's sleep. (D)

MAR 16, 2018: DUBLIN Journey outside Dublin today on a full day excursion to Belfast. Belfast was the only city in Ireland to experience the full force of the Industrial revolution, and in which it played a key role. Linen, rope making, tobacco and most famously ship building including the building of the Titanic on the Harland & Wolff shipyard were the main industries. Take a tour with a local guide to learn the history of the city and see the Loyalist Shankhill Road and Republican Falls Road. Next, a static performance at the Titanic Belfast's outdoor plaza is possible - weather permitting. Then, explore the newly opened and impressive Titanic Museum this afternoon and see the enormous Titanic Dry Dock that remains unchanged since 1911. Return to your hotel for a 7:30pm dinner together. Return to the hotel to change after your performance. Return to the center where you will be given tickets to the Dublin Fun Fairs in Merrion Square and Custom House (schedule TBD, pending confirmation). Return to the hotel for dinner together at 7pm. (B,D)

MAR 18, 2018: LIMERICK Board your coach and head southwest today, where you will participate in the Limerick Marching Festival! Assemble in Perry Square for the start of the parade. Spend some time enjoying the parade and the presentations afterward in Arthur Quay's Park. Later, visit Bunratty Castle and Folk Park, considered to be the most authentically restored castle in all of Ireland! Check in to the Clarion Hotel and have dinner together. Tonight, the orchestra will perform a concert in conjunction with a local ensemble (pending approval)! (B,D)

MAR 19, 2018: LIMERICK Journey to the Cliffs of Moher today, and travel through The Burren. The Burren is famous for its Lunar-like Limestone landscape and its unique flora. About 20 species of Orchids also grow wild here. Continue along Galway Bay and spend the rest of the afternoon exploring the lovely city of Galway. Return to Limerick, where you will enjoy a special farewell Medieval Banquet at Knapogue Castle! Listen to music of the harp and fiddle followed by Medieval choral singing from the ladies. You will experience why Sean Lord of Clancullen had a reputation for lavish parties and royal entertainment. (B,D)

MAR 20, 2018: DUBLIN Return to Dublin this morning via Blarney Castle, where you'll have the chance to gain 'the gift of gab' by kissing the Blarney Stone! Next, see the Rock of Cashel, the seat of kings and medieval bishops for 900 years that flourished until the early 17th century. Brian Ború was crowned King of Munster here in 977 and he became High King of Ireland in 1002. Continue to Dublin and check in to the Maldron Newlands Cross Hotel before enjoying an exciting traditional Irish evening of music and dance at Merry Ploughboys Pub! (B,D)
