

## **Code of Conduct & Rules of Travel**

This document is a general overview establishing our company's expectations for student and adult behavior while participating in any of our programs. We suggest director's and chaperones review the Terms & Conditions stipulated in your original contract for specific information regarding behavior at this event.

- 1. The student is to follow the directions and the rules and regulations established by the director, the chaperones and/or by Worldstrides OnStage during the tour.
- 2. No use of tobacco, alcohol or non-prescription drugs by students is allowed. Prescription drugs may be used only in accordance with a doctor's written instructions. Adult chaperones should not consume alcohol or non-prescription drugs while fulfilling their duties of protecting and monitoring the youth.
- 3. Drugs –If traveling internationally, international laws and penalties with regard to the possession and usage of narcotics are more severe than those in the United States. Whether a juvenile or adult, you are out of the U.S. government jurisdiction. All drug use is strictly prohibited.
- 4. The student shall comply with all rules and regulations of the various governmental agencies and third party vendors such as airlines, hotels, bus companies, museums, theme parks etc.
- 5. The use of hotel facilities carries with it the responsibility of leaving them in the same condition in which they were found. The student is held responsible for any damages to hotel property and will be billed accordingly.
- 6. Quiet hours at the hotel will be observed from 10:00pm until 6:00am. Curfew at the various hotels may vary, but 10:00pm is established for our participants. Students must remain in their rooms until the start of the following day's activities unless accompanied by an adult.
- 7. Students may not leave the group at any time unless specifically authorized to do so by the chaperones or the director.
- 8. The student must sleep in his/her assigned hotel room each night.
- 9. The student is solely responsible for keeping personal belongings safe. Worldstrides OnStage is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 10. If the student should violate any of these rules, he/she may be sent home at the sole discretion of the chaperones or the director. In such cases, the parent/guardian will be contacted and the student sent home at the parent's/guardian's expense.
