- a. Financial Report (M. Bohannon)
 - \$14,000 deficit of the program;
 - Extremely expensive for band as opposed to other programs;
 - The district pays for 45% of instructors' salaries. It is believed that the district pays more to sports;
 - L-CAP sets the priorities for the programs for the school. The meeting is on 3/15 and Wayne will be representing the band at the meeting;
 - There is no extra money in the budget;
 - The 7/8 Dinner Show netted approx. \$5K; and
 - \$15K in student account for students that will not be used by the MPA.
- b. Instructor's Reports (Mr. Stone, Ms. Munday; Mr. Myers)
 Jason:
 - Prepping for festival is underway, 3/20 is festival and 3/11 is the concert;
 - Winter Guard goes to Monrovia HS on Saturday on the 29th
 - Drumline is this Saturday at Monrovia
 - Concert band received 1st place and 2nd place after penalties
 - NY after the MPA Mtg in March we will have a meeting regarding the itinerary. We have a 6:15 a.m. flight on Saturday the 4th so we will meet at LAX around 3:30 or 4 a.m. We return at noon on Wednesday.
