d. Financial Report (Charles Thuss)

- Board signature adjustments made to the bank account, and another account closed
- Thank you, Marshall and Elizabeth for the help and setting up a good system moving forward
- Today share a <u>review of the budget</u> for the coming year, which was already reviewed with Dino, Jason, Marshall, Elizabeth, and Octavia.
  - Charles asked Wayne to look at it
- Packet or screen, in summary this year:
  - o gross profit \$52,000
  - \$42,000 operating expenses
  - \$10,000 for reserves, will keep an even keel
- REVENUE REVIEW
  - Missing traditional fund raiser events and trips = both lower revenue and expenses
  - Our student donations estimate
    - \$200 for band, color guard, orchestra,
    - \$50 for 7/8 orchestra and band,
    - \$500 drumline,
    - \$200 instrument rental
    - \$600 Winterguard
  - Donation requests comparable to years past, except marching competition cut and orchestra travel cut, Band reduce cost to \$200, a membership donation
  - Compared to last year: Band was \$1400, now \$400 (including rental instrument)
    - Staff expenses thru Dec., listed
      - Winter staffing costs will be offset by winter donation/fees
      - Jason "Trying to keep staff in front of kids"
  - Jason acquired the instrument fund contribution from the city
  - Unrestricted contributions- general private donation, Charles will add more specific labeling
  - Student fundraiser bake sale and Go Fund Me earned \$3,500, will be used to offset T-shirt expenses, performing well, may exceed \$6,300
  - Poinsettia sales-
    - Last year 600 poinsettias ordered and sold
    - Giving \$4 per plant to the Student MPA Account, remaining profit goes to MPA
    - Wayne ordered 600 for this year, can adjust 10% more or less, we sell for \$12 each, each pot costs \$5.50, \$2.50 per plant MPA profit, Wayne orders and Rose manages sale, Wayne will touch bass w Rose

- ~\$120 amazon smile and ~\$1,000 scrip Cici confirms
- No trips budgeted this year
- Do expect donations of \$33,000 out of \$50,000
- Unrestricted boosters and other- historically \$9,000
  - Wayne still needs more info on the itemization
  - Marshall Bohannon- said these are random personal donations, like ralphs, Coldwell Banker, corporate donations, not sponsorship or advertising (that is in dinner show),
  - \$3,000 from GoFundMe
  - Charles thought from seniors donations
  - Discussion on how to categorize random donations,
    Restricted is grant money, everything else in unrestricted
  - Charles will work with Wayne on nomenclature
  - Wayne thought we can get \$1,000 more out of this, leaving at \$5,000
- Testing fundraiser all distance learning, not in unrestricted category, estimate \$1,000 like prior year, 4 dates
- Any new incomes to be considered? "No", will know more in Dec.
- No orchestra uniform costs budgeted for this year, kids pay directly for items, income and expense wash out, Freshmen will need new uniforms
- A music registration form will be designed for the next constant contact
  - All fees will be collected online
  - Some instruments currently checked out
  - O Who will monitor payments and receipts?
    - Michelle Wilcox and Mark will check money in and out
    - Jason and Jenifer will cross check
    - A system is not in place yet, but Michelle is working on something
    - Michelle, Mark, Jason, and Jennifer will work out the form and management

#### EXPENSES REVIEW

- Expenses are down w/o performances
  - Costly maintenance, insurance, and vehicle use are low
- \$42,000 in budgeted expenses
- Michelle explained some future website needs:
  - The domain and server costs are on a 3 yr cycle, currently coming to an end.
  - \$100 needs to paid with a credit card for the current deal.
  - Has been a traditional donation by Michelle, but she is graduating this year, so she needs to shift payment to MPA accounting.

- Jason said We have no MPA credit card. MPA VP of Communications for next year will pay fee and get reimbursed.
- Note if not paid, the web site goes off-line. Need a replacement VP of Communications in place for next year.
- Charles called for vote to approve the MPA 2020-2021 Budget. Dino motioned to approve, and Wayne seconded motion. MPA 2020-2021 Budget approved.
- e. Instructor's Reports (Mr. Stone, Ms. Munday; Mr. Myers)
  - Mr. Stone
    - o Challenges
      - Early morning loud instrument playing for families at home
      - Tuesday night practices restarted, causing scheduling stress for some
      - Concern about Spartan Connect, which was canceled, so band may use some of those time slots,
      - Jason is collecting feedback from students, to get their pulse and then will adjust for next week
    - Goal
      - Jason wants to connect the kids constantly
      - Jason is concerned about freshmen, it is a tough time to get them connected
    - Working for the show
      - Tuesday night drums and color guard practices will continue on with staff members
      - Will start working on a winter show, hope to perform it in person
      - First snippet is raw, more polish coming, 2-3 more movements
      - Tough teaching at home
        - to motivate the kids to practice
        - checking on the kids
    - No upcoming in person events
    - Video in Oct, premier night
  - Ms. Munday
    - Impressed with kids showing up at 7:45 in morning
    - Students got their orchestra music packets last weekend
      - solo study music, private lesson style
    - Chamber music groups forming
    - 3 coaches + Jennifer
      - new cello coach coming

- Kids seem excited, Jennifer is impressed with their acceptance of the circumstance
- Oct 28 fall concert changed to small chamber group recordings and a live stream event
- Winter spectacular hope to play together again, will happen in some capacity
- Biggest challenge breakout rooms, but all are getting better with the routine
- Mr. Myers
  - Jason said 7/8 is trucking along prepping for Oct projects
- f. Communications Report: (Michele Wilcox)
  - Michelle introduced herself and job as liaison between instructors and parents, improving communication of pertinent information.
  - 3 modes of communication
    - Sandy's weekly emailed newsletter, usually Sunday eve
    - Facebook group not a promotion group, but intended to communicate details about group activities, like a rehearsal time change
    - LCHS Music Department website has the general info (lchsmusic.org)
      - news blog from emailed newsletter
      - Google calendar has everything Michelle hears about
        - Calendar can be integrated into parent and student Google calendars.
        - Calendar has some zoom links, recommended for new parents
      - Media page, storage of all shared and posted parent media
      - Michelle's email address is on the website; she can direct you to getting questions answered
      - Website not totally updated yet, needs new student positions updated
  - Jason- Mr Eick built the LC Play+ Website to promote student performances
    - o lcplayplus.com
    - Music videos posted in Music Makers link
    - Michelle will get that on website
- g. Fundraising Report (Wayne Page)
  - SAT and ACT Practice Exam Fundraiser:
    - First on-line test date Sept 19<sup>th</sup> Saturday

- Need to go over how to market all fundraising events
- Poinsettias are ordered
- Sunday Funday Fiesta night dinner at Dona Maria
  - 40% profits back to MPA
  - Starts Sept 6<sup>th</sup>
  - 40 weekends throughout year
  - last Spring event made \$900
  - they need some help in an easy way to set up orders off-line
  - all for take-out
- Drive-in Movies
  - families coming together in parking lot, practicing social distancing, substitute Friday night lights for football
    - a. St Bedes parking lot (screen?)
    - b. Band lot (wall) upon district approval
  - Sony movies supporting by authorizing movie use, including current features
  - Waiting on school lot permissions
- Booster- thons (Wayne is also a director on LCHS Boosters Booster supports all athletic, arts, and enrichment program support)
  - Anchored by 4 performing arts, music from band and orchestra,
    7/8 too, choral groups, TV, entire campus, sport teams as well
  - Will allow fundraising directly to the MPA, sell t-shirts for donations
  - Wayne needs specific numbers on how much funding MPA needs to run and how much parents put into MPA – need to tell that story as 2 numbers – how many instructors MPA pays?
    - Jason –11/14 instructors MPA pays
      - i. 10 instructors MPA pays for
      - ii. MPA pays Jimmy partial (brass coach only)
      - iii. 3 teachers covered by district
      - iv. MPA pays 55% of staff
      - v. MPA covers 100% program costs
        - 1. Jason's school budget is \$0
        - 2. ASB also \$0
        - 3. they don't buy materials or instruments
        - 4. stands last year came from a city grant
  - Any other parents who want to get involved with Booster-thon contact Wayne Page <waynenpage@gmail.com>
    - parents will be shepherding kid groups who do the work
    - parents will help mostly with marketing, advertisement, and sponsorship
- Banner Ads:
  - nonintrusive running on the side of Booster-thon performances

- Jason and Jennifer talk to Wayne about what these ads should promote
- In absence of a program, the banner could introduce a section
- Potential area to raise funds and connect to community.
- Most parents have not seen the other programs on campus
- Potential to help elementary kids get excited about getting involved in high school music
- Fun host bits (play-ons, gags, host band) offers potential to get all kids in a program
